



KNIT ALONG THE ROCKIES- 2013

NEEDLEWORKS – COLORADO SPRINGS  
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**10” square afghan block**

125 yards dk weight yarn

Size 6 or 7 needle (or size needed to get gauge)

Markers

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Cast on 51 stitches

Seed stitch 6 rows (k1, p1, k1, p1, etc, ending with k1)

Begin and end all of the following rows with 5 stitch seed stitch (k1, p1, k1,p1, k1)

Pattern arrangement is as follows:

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[5 sts seed] [7 sts Chart A] [4 sts Chart D] [20-24 sts Chart C] [4 sts Chart B] [7 sts Chart A] [5 sts seed]

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(Special Instructions) -- Chart C

When beginning Chart C you will initially have only 19 stitches until you do the M1 on the first row only the first time through the chart. Thereafter that stitch is just a knit stitch. At this point your stitch count should be 52 stitches.

When finishing Chart C for the final time, P2tog in the middle of row 24 leaving 19 stitches in Chart C row 24, in order to reduce your stitch count to 51 stitches. This will enable you to do the final 6 rows in seed stitch easily.

Odd number = right side rows. Even number rows = wrong side rows.

Read charts from right to left for right side rows; from left to right for wrong side rows.

Repeat Chart C three times.

Repeat all other charts as needed to complete Chart C

Complete block by doing 6 rows seed stitch. Bind off knit wise. Block as needed.

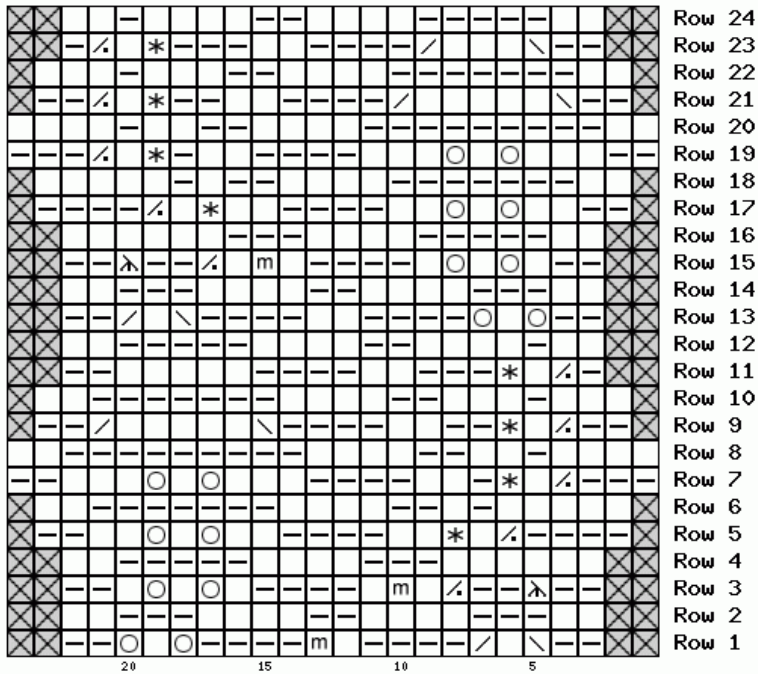

- / k2tog (knit two together)
- \ p2tog (purl two together)
- / sk2p (slip one, knit two together, pass slipped stitch over)
- \* a (m1 purlwise)
