This wonderful traditionally European knitting technique is fascinating and a great way to expand your knitting skills while creating your own stunning one-of-a-kind, functional garment.

The first session on Saturday will concentrate on the basic knitting technique, making samples of both the single color and the two color patterns.

The second session on Sunday will introduce you to a two color cable cast-on, left and right increases and decreases, plus cables, diagonal stitch movement, etc. The class project, a one or two color cowl, will be started when you are comfortable with the necessary maneuvers.

Finishing includes the blocking, sewing together of a knitted garment (for those who love to knit but abhor the assembly!) or the work done to block and finish a needlepoint project into an ornament, pillow, etc. Our finishers have extensive experience and will take your lovely project to the next level with care and consideration. Knitting repairs are often needed when a favorite knitted garment has a snag or a raveled area that needs a certain expertise to stop the damage from going any further and bring it back to a nice, wearable condition. Be sure to bring it in sooner rather than (too!) later!
